We are in the heart of the Mediterranean region, two steps away from the Adriatic sea, but not a year passes without abundant snows, which in the winter months cover with a white blanket, the more than seventy summits of the Majella heights, protected by the most important national parks in Europe.

The story of the Majella landscape is long, tormented by processes of mechanical erosion and chemicals. And to study its morphology and the intimate nature of its rocks, one must follow the flow of the water, which in all its forms, liquid or ice, has profoundly modified the sedimentary rocks. The Majella is an ancient mountain formed by huge limestone deposits which came from the bottom of the ancient sea, called Tetide, millions of years ago.
